



DNA 1 PURPOSE

Forensic DNA analysis is the process of identification of biological evidence in criminal matters using DNA technologies. The function of the DNA section of the CBI-FS is to examine items submitted for biological analysis with the goal of developing a DNA profile from evidentiary items. The methods of analysis used in these examinations are listed in the technical procedures, Units 10, 11, 12, and 13. They detail step-by-step procedures in the use of reagents, standards, controls, instrumentation, analysis, and interpretation necessary in the performance of the prescribed analyses.
